CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

(amended 6 May 2017)

- The competition is open to anyone (professional, amateur or emerging artist or groups).
- Maximum 2 entries per person (or group).
- A non-refundable entry fee of **\$10** per entry is required upon registration.
- Entries will be accepted in two categories; Youth (up to 17 yrs) or Open (18 yrs +).
- Categories will be judged separately and a People's Choice prize awarded for each category.
- Cash Prizes will be: Open (Winner) \$1,000, Open (Merit) \$600, Open People's Choice \$500, Youth (Winner) \$500, Youth (Merit) \$300, Youth People's Choice \$100. The judges' decision is final.
- A minimum of 5 entries per category must be received for sculptures to be judged and prizes awarded.
- All sculptures must be composed of predominately discarded, salvaged, reused or recycled materials **not previously entered in this competition.**
- Sculpture will be judged on creativity, innovation, standard of production and technical expertise.
- Materials for sticking, fixing, joining, gluing etc. may be new, but take the challenge to recycle, reclaim, borrow etc. where possible.
- Sculpture must be no larger than 3m x 3m x 3m (please indicate actual size on Entry Form).
- Sculpture to be freestanding or self-supporting. Indicate preference of tabletop or floor* on entry form to assist with allocation of display space. **Protection must be used to safeguard tiles.*
- If it is essential for your sculpture to be hung, it is the responsibility of the artist to provide appropriate free standing hanging devices etc.
- All decisions pertaining to the display of the sculptures is at the discretion of the competition organiser.
- In the event that a sculpture is deemed unsuitable or does not meet the competition criteria, the competition organiser reserves the right to withdraw it from the competition.
- Sculptures are entered and exhibited at the artists own risk. The competition organiser accepts no responsibility/liability for any damage incurred to the sculpture during the exhibition. It is the artists responsibility to arrange insurance protection for the sculpture if deemed necessary.
- All entries must include a brief '**Artist Statement**' (max 100 words) including a description of the sculpture and materials used. *Note: it is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that the statement is accurate and free of errors as it will accompany the work on display.*
- Entry forms must be completed in full and lodged with entry fee and Artists Statement, at the Loxton Visitor Information Centre, on the Roundabout, 7 Bookpurnong Terrace Loxton.
- Entries close at **5pm Friday 4th August 2017.**
- All sculptures must be displayed for judging at Riverland Ford, 1 East Terrace on Sunday August 13th 2017 between 10am and 3pm. Winners will be announced at 1.30pm.
- Sculptures can be delivered and set up at Riverland Ford, 1 East Terrace on either Saturday 12th August 2017 from 3pm - 5pm, or Sunday 13th August 2017 from 9am - 10am.
- Sculptures must be collected on Sunday 13th August 2017 between 3pm - 4pm. Sculptures not collected by 4pm will be held at the Loxton Visitor Information Centre for a maximum of 2 days. After this time the sculpture will be disposed of.
- Artists agree to their names and images of their entries being used for promotional purposes.
- Winning sculptures will be invited to be exhibited as part of the August Art Trail from Monday 14th to Thursday 31st August 2017 (subject to size).
